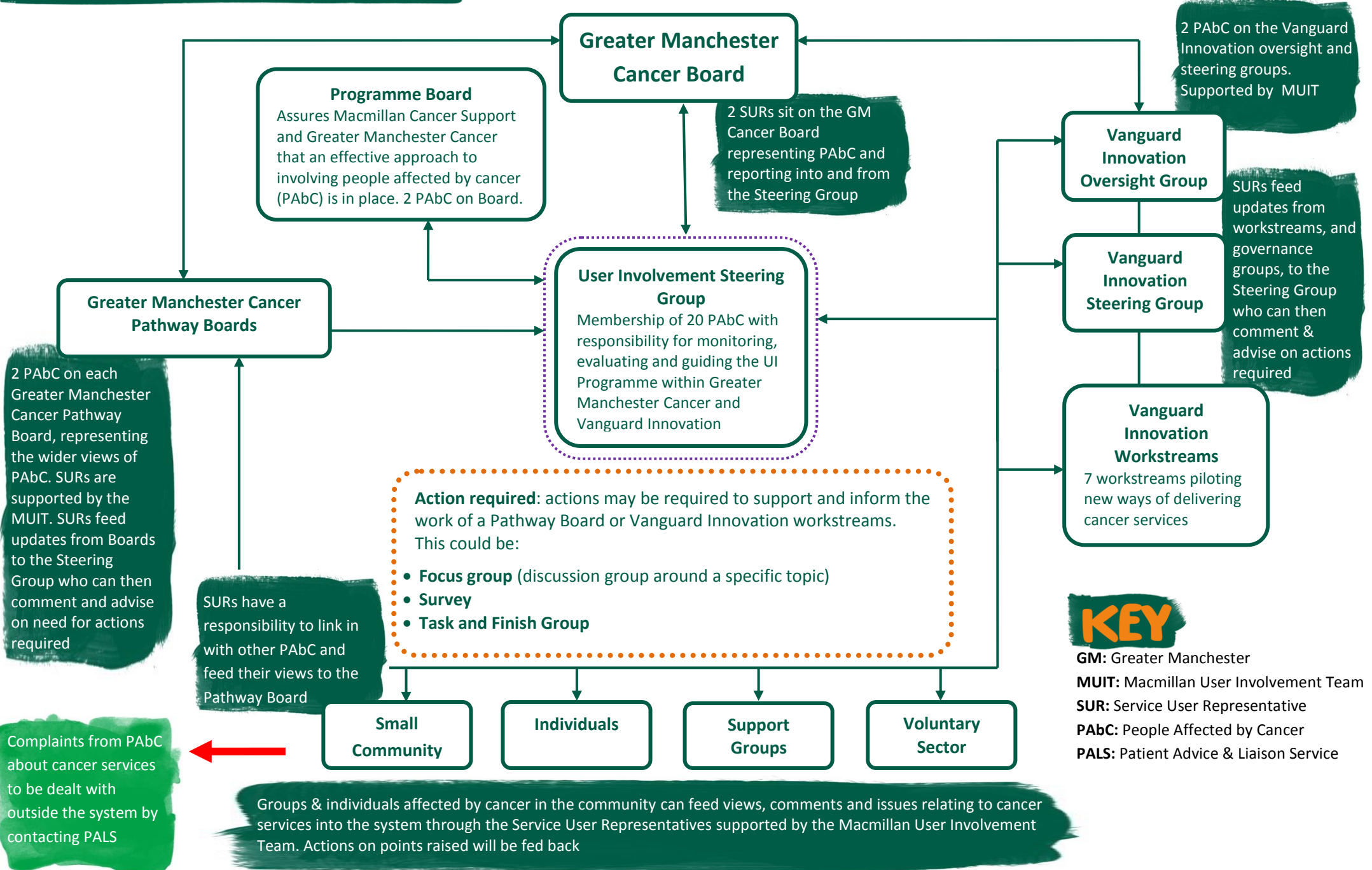


# MACMILLAN USER INVOLVEMENT REPORTING STRUCTURE



**This reporting structure identifies the opportunities for people affected by cancer to influence and support the design, development and implementation of services and innovation projects across Greater Manchester Cancer.**

**All work undertaken in the User Involvement Programme uses a model of **CO-PRODUCTION** which means designing and delivering services in partnership with people affected by cancer.**

**Steering Group (SG):** The SG is a representative group of people affected by cancer with responsibility for monitoring, evaluating and guiding the User Involvement Programme within Greater Manchester Cancer. Ultimately, all user involvement reporting lines feed into and out of the SG. Service User Representatives (SURs) on all clinical pathway boards, Vanguard Innovation workstreams and governance groups regularly report and update SG members on progress and outcomes of work. The SG may then make recommendations as to actions that need to be taken. The SG also meet in line with the Greater Manchester Cancer Board so that comments on agenda items can be fed up to the Board through the SURs.

**Programme Board:** The Programme Board provides programme funders with assurances that User Involvement is taking place in accordance with funding requirements, using a model of co-production and in a meaningful and effective way. PAbC sit on the Programme Board and again feed into and out of the Steering Group.

**Greater Manchester Pathway Boards:** At least 2 SURs sit on each of the pathway boards, with a responsibility for representing the wider views of PAbC. To enable this process, SURs are linked with a smaller community of PAbC who offer wider views on work relating to the Boards and also ask the SUR to raise issues relating to cancer care to be considered by the Board. Where no small community exists, SURs are supported to develop links with PAbC in the wider community through existing support groups, individuals and voluntary sector organisations.

**Vanguard Innovation Governance Groups and Workstreams:** PAbC are involved in supporting the Vanguard Innovation workstream projects and 2 SURs sit on the Steering Group and Oversight Group, representing the wider views of PAbC. Again, SURs are linked to the wider views of PAbC through groups in the community to gain views and ideas on innovation work taking place.
